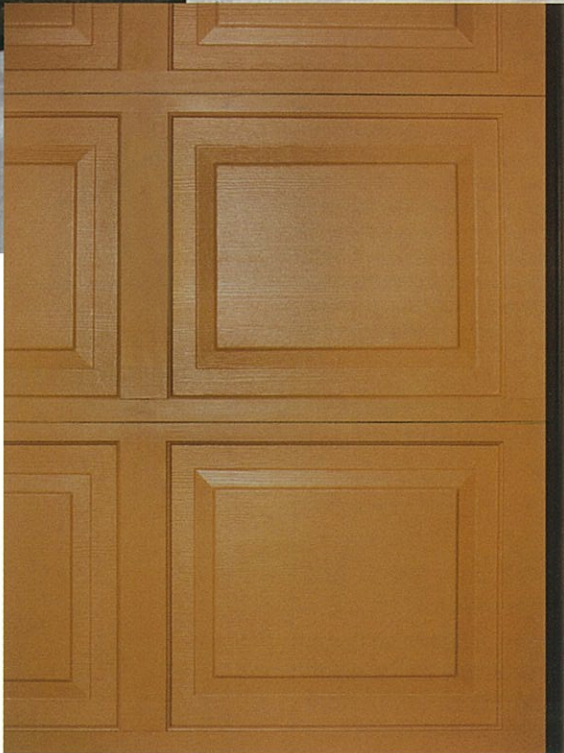

General Doors' Cladwood Raised Panel Garage Door has the look, feel and sound of wood, but it is even better. That's because the Cladwood panels are durable and weather proof. They won't split, crack, check or delaminate—even under extreme weather conditions.

Panels are constructed of medium density particle board, covered front and back with a refined wood fiber overlay, then molded under extreme pressure and heat to fuse them into a single, homogeneous product. Phenolic resin in the overlay and the particle board make each panel highly resistant to moisture.

This means that for a surprisingly low cost (not much more than a standard panel door) the Cladwood Raised Panel Door offers long-life and a classic, three dimensional appearance. Superior millwork, quality materials, and proven performance make this garage door the best value in the industry today.

Manufactured from the finest grades of select lumber, Cladwood doors are available in most standard sizes and are equipped with easy-to-operate hardware.

FEATURES

- All stiles and rails are of kiln dried select grade lumber. Most doors manufactured with finger-jointed lumber, although clear rails may be available if required.
- Wedge-Rite track for a tight-fit, yet still allowing an easy-glide motion without binding or sticking.
- All galvanized steel hardware.

WEATHER TIGHT FIT

Insulating efficiency is an important consideration to most homeowners. Wood doors offer many benefits in that regard. Unlike metal doors which conduct heat and cold, a wood door is a natural insulator. Additionally, a wood door can be easily fitted and weather stripped (it's nearly impossible to custom fit a non-wood door). And proper fitting is extremely important because most heat loss comes from air infiltration around a door, not through it.

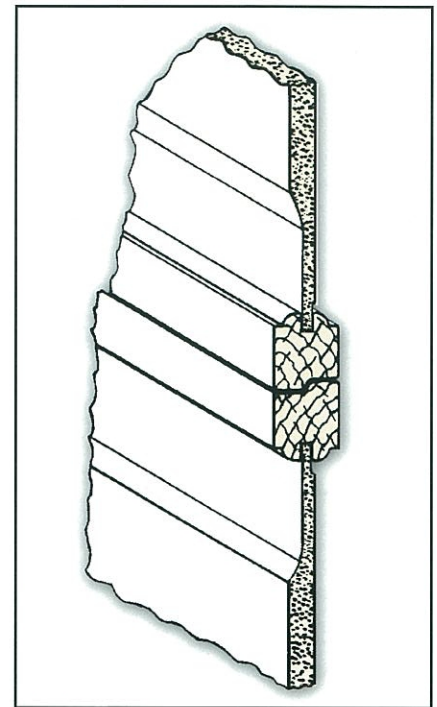
WARRANTY
